Because the 4th of July was on a Thursday, our usual 6:30 PM run was held at 10:00 AM instead. That time wasn't too early for most hashers; in fact, many of them had arrived at Charles Wilson Park even earlier to run a 5K first! Overachievers! Then there was **POOR AIM**, who did a r-r-r-race in Huntington Beach beforehand and still managed to make the 10AM start. The hares led us off on a chase through the park and some kind of swap meet/carnival event. We continued on down train tracks and into several alleys and neighborhoods. Scribe **AUTO DO ME** said it was so boring that she didn't wake up until the beer check. Fortunately, the second half of trail was much more interesting as that led to some shiggy and a small creek. A short ways downstream trail took us through a hole in a fence and out onto the streets of Torrance. It was here we ran past the Pussycat Theatre where *Fruit Does The Hash* was playing along with *Taboo VII* and *Maid for Service*. The hares had made arrangements with the theatre management to alter their marquee especially for the occasion, and had chalked "**FRUIT**, look up" on the sidewalk to make sure he noticed! 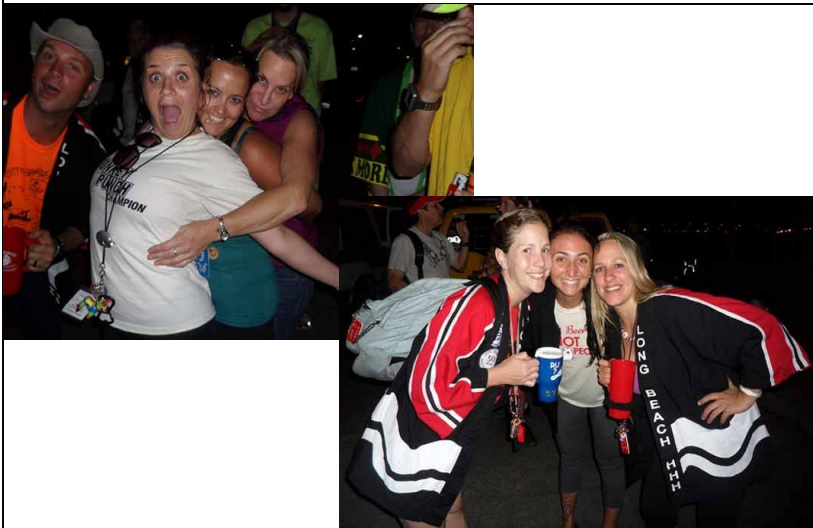
25 YEARS AGO - JULY 1986

From the 405, 605, 710 or 91 Fwys, make your way to the intersection of Carson St. and Los Coyotes Diagonal. Head North on Los Coyotes across Carson and take the 1st left which is Harvey St. Take 2nd right (just past Quigley) onto Shadeway Rd. After 9 short blocks and 2 stop signs, you will see a house on your right which has a long white wall topped with wrought iron. Take the next right into Monte Verde park parking lot. There are 75 parking spots. The best map in on www.lakewoodcity.org -Mae Boyar Park. Monte Verde Park is just south of Mae Boyar Park.
